- All Industry Based Accreditations any applicable or appropriate industry code of conduct, guide or code of practice; for example:
 - o Dangerous Goods
 - Food Safety

 - \circ Customer specific standards of operation, codes of conduct, and policies and procedures for the handling and transport of goods
